Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred S.B. No. 295, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to promote the use of hybrid vehicles and other energy-efficient vehicles, including plug-in hybrid electric vehicles, by allowing these vehicles to use high occupancy vehicle (HOV) lanes, regardless of the number of occupants in the vehicle.

The Department of Transportation, Hawaiian Electric Company, Inc., Maui Electric Company, Ltd., and Hawaii Electric Light Company, Inc., testified in support of this bill.

Energy-efficient vehicles, such as hybrid vehicles and plugin hybrid vehicles, are gaining increased acceptance in the consumer market. These vehicles are being purchased in greater numbers and are becoming a more common sight on our roadways. The use of these vehicles not only reduces the consumption of fossil fuels but also aids in the reduction of pollution, including greenhouse-gas emissions. Providing incentives for the purchase and use of these vehicles, such as allowing these vehicles to use HOV lanes regardless of the number of occupants, will benefit the environment and decrease the State's dependence on fossil fuels.
