The purpose of this measure is to grant family leave to an employee to provide family care and support during the military deployment of the employee's child, spouse, reciprocal beneficiary, or parent.

Your Committee also finds that this measure will help to alleviate many of the stresses that some employees face on a daily basis when their child, spouse, reciprocal beneficiary, or parent is deployed.
