The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to request the Department of Public Safety (PSD) and the Hawaii Paroling Authority (HPA) to identify up to 500 non-violent inmates who could be involved in a day reporting center, be monitored via 24hour/seven days a week GPS electronic monitoring, be included in an extended work furlough program, and/or be eligible for an early release program.

The Drug Policy Forum of Hawaii, Community Alliance on Prisons, and several concerned individuals testified in support of this concurrent resolution. PSD and HPA opposed this measure. Hawaii Substance Abuse Coalition provided comments.
