Requires medicaid contracts between the department of human services and medicaid healthcare insurance plan contractors to contain

provisions affecting the reimbursement obligations in the policies between the medicaid healthcare insurance plan contractors and the home and community-based case management agencies. Prohibits

reductions of reimbursements of more than 25%.

SB 2137 RELATING TO HEALTH CLUBS. PSM/CPN, JGO

<u>Testimony</u> Allows military personnel deployed outside the State on federal active duty to cancel or suspend health club membership at any time during

the contract term under certain conditions.
