Defines the practice of nursing; directs the state board of nursing to (SSCR2302) adopt certain provisions of the NCSBN Model Nursing Practice Act and Model Nursing Administrative Rules; delineates the scope of **Testimony** practice for registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, and advanced **Status** practice registered nurses; repeals Hawaii Administrative Rules relating to prescriptive authority for advanced practice registered nurses and amends the definition of "advanced practice nurse with prescriptive authority" to reflect this. (SD1) SB 2491, SD1 RELATING TO TELEMEDICINE. HTH, CPN Clarifies telehealth as a practice of medicine. Amends liability (SSCR2139) insurance provisions to allow for telehealth coverage under medical malpractice insurance. Effective 7/1/50. (SD1) **Testimony Status** SB 2390, SD1 RELATING TO PHARMACIST LICENSURE. HTH/HRE, CPN Broadens the practical experience requirements for a pharmacist (SSCR2208) license to include experience obtained in U.S. territories and the District of Columbia. Removes the requirement that supervision must **Testimony** take place in a pharmacy. Broadens the experience requirements to **Status** relate to the practice of pharmacy. (SD1)

(SSCR2303) Clarifies the definitions of "remote dispensing machine" and "remote

HTH, CPN SB 2811, SD1 Requires all pharmacies and remote dispensing pharmacies to have the (SSCR2304) capacity to accommodate electronic prescriptions. Requires all pharmacies and dispensing pharmacies to maintain prescription records **Testimony** electronically. Effective 7/1/50. (SD1) **Status** SB 2102, SD1 RELATING TO PRESCRIPTION DRUGS. HTH, CPN Requires providers of accident or health and sickness insurance to base [Measure Added: (SSCR2207) prescription drug coverage a drug formulary or prior authorization 02/16/10] requirements established and regularly updated by a drug formulary **Testimony** advisory board whose membership includes a majority of Hawaii **Status** residents or practitioners. Effective 7/1/50. (SD1) SB 2343, SD1 RELATING TO INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR MAMMOGRAMS. HTH, CPN Prohibits an insurer from requiring a doctor's referral for annual (SSCR2068) mammograms for covered individuals over forty years old. (SD1) **Testimony Status** RELATING TO LIMITED BENEFIT HEALTH INSURANCE. SB 2371, SD1 HTH, CPN Excludes limited benefit health insurance and medicare supplements (SSCR2067) from provisions of chapter 431:10A enacted after July 1, 2010. (SD1) **Testimony Status SB 2698** RELATING TO INSURANCE. HTH, CPN Mandates the offer of health insurance coverage for dependents up to (SSCR2260) age 27 at the option of the parents. (SD1) **Testimony Status** SB 2271, SD1 RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUMS. HTH, CPN Increases health insurance premium transparence, requires an annual [Measure Added: (SSCR2258) premium transparency report, and creates a health information data 02/16/10] clearinghouse; requires a minimum amount of premiums to be spent on **Testimony** medical expenses. Effective date 7/1/50. (SD1) Status RELATING TO DENTISTRY. HTH, CPN **SB 2188** Redefines the practice of dentistry to include teeth whitening. (SSCR2137) **Testimony Status** SB 2126, SD1 RELATING TO DENTAL SERVICES. HTH, CPN Prohibits an accident and health or sickness insurer, mutual benefit [Measure Added: (SSCR2259) society, health maintenance organization, or dental service 02/16/101 organization from requiring a dentist who provides services to its **Testimony** subscribers to accept a fee set by the accident and health or sickness Status insurer, mutual benefit society, health maintenance organization, or dental service organization unless the services are covered under the applicable subscriber agreement. Effective 7/1/50. (SD1)
