	from a trust. Requires annual statements of the disposition of trust	
	funds.	

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<u>SB 2516</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE FUNERAL INDUSTRY. Creates a standardized form for cemetery and pre-need funeral authorities' financial statements and actuarial reports. Ensures sufficient funds are available to cover future claims. Requires the department of commerce and consumer affairs to report to the legislature on the status of licensees required to submit audited financial statements and actuarial reports.	CPN
<u>SB 2601</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO ATHLETIC TRAINERS. Requires athletic trainers to register with the department of commerce and consumer affairs.	CPN

Testimony	Requires that the developer collect a percentage of the initial sales
