RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

EBM, FIN

Status

Amends the Hawaii public procurement code to make public contracts

effective as of the notice of the award. Specifies that the solicitation, offer, bid, or proposal and the award notice constitute the entire contract. Provides that a subsequent written and executed contract is

not required.
