PROPOSED SB2545 SD2 HD 1: Restricts to 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.,

BYOB liquor consumption on premises not licensed by a liquor commission. Establishes a class 17 license for BYOB establishments operating between 12:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. Increases limit on onpremises brewpub license manufacturing from 10,000 to 30,000

barrels. Effective July 1, 2020.
