RELATING TO PREAUDITS FOR PROPOSED PAYMENTS.

<u>Testimony</u> Status Clarifies that the department of education is required to preaudit

proposed payments of \$10,000 or more. Allows the University of Hawaii and the department of education to preaudit sample populations for proposed payments of less than \$10,000 to determine the propriety of expenditures and compliance with applicable laws, executive orders, and rules, as their respective chief financial officers determine to be appropriate. Extends the date until which the University of Hawaii and the department of education shall have autonomous authority over their accounting systems and other purchasing responsibilities and duties.

RELATING TO ELECTRONIC WARRANT VOUCHERS.

<u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u> Allows the department of education, department of accounting and general services, and the University of Hawaii to accept electronically mailed warrant vouchers for bills of materials, supplies, and incidentals as original documentation, the receipt of which authorizes payment to

be made to each individual to whom the State is indebted.
