the academic and financial plans of their respective schools.

Removing the authority of principals to set aside any decision made by

school community councils.

HB 2740 Status RELATING TO SCHOOLS.

EDN, FIN

Directs the department of education to enter into a financing agreement

for the planning and design of the Royal Kunia Elementary School II

using certificates of participation.
