Provides an exemption for projects that protect, preserve, and enhance the environment, land, or natural resources, under certain conditions. Requires the environmental council to make a determination of whether the exemption should be applicable after a public hearing.	ENE/WTL
<u>SB 2923</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO SOLAR ENERGY. Authorizes solar energy facilities on class B and C agricultural land; requires the solar energy facility on class B and C land to provide for the energy requirements via a renewable energy source for the agricultural operations on the land on which the solar energy facility is established. <u>SB 2520</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE HAWAIIAN HOMES COMMISSION ACT. Authorizes the native Hawaiian lessees of Hawaiian homestead land to sublease a portion of their land to renewable energy producers.	ENE/WTL
<u>SB 2526</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO WIND ENERGY FACILITIES. Provides for a setback when wind energy facilities are being used in agricultural districts.	ENE/WTL
