Retains the State's ability to "pick-up" the state death tax credit as it existed in the Internal Revenue Code before the enactment of the

Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001.

HB 2313

RELATING TO TAXATION.

FIN

<u>Status</u>

Repeals the income tax provision that requires the reporting of

gambling winnings but not losses.

HB 2596 <u>Status</u>

RELATING TO TAX CREDITS.

FIN

Provides for the statutory ordering of income tax credits, which requires the claiming of refundable credits first, followed by

nonrefundable credits.

HB 2868 Status

RELATING TO TAXATION.

FIN

Places a cap on itemized deductions claimed on state income tax

returns. Applies to taxable years beginning after 12/31/09 and sunsets

on 12/31/15.



FIN RELATING TO TAX DEDUCTIONS. HB 2869 Adopts the federal tax deduction limitation with modifications. **Status** FIN RELATING TO TAXATION. HB 2870 Removes the refunding feature of the capital goods excise tax credit **Status** from 01/01/10 to 12/31/15. FIN RELATING TO TAXATION. HB 2890 Imposes the income tax on a lessor of real property for capital **Status** improvements made by a lessee upon the termination of a lease.
