<u>SB 2626, SD1</u> (HSCR788-10) Status

#### RELATING TO PUBLIC SERVICE.

LAB, FIN

Requires every state agency to report to the legislature all non-civil service, temporary employees employed by the agency for each quarterly period of the fiscal year. Establishes a definition for initial probation period; amends section 27(a)(1), HRS, to provide that the initial probation period for a person transferring between a position exempt under section 76-16, HRS, to a civil service position between 12/15/2009 and 12/31/2011 shall be 12 months.

SB 2849, SD2 (HSCR837-10) Status

# RELATING TO THE HAWAII EMPLOYER-UNION HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST FUND.

LAB, FIN

Adds three new sections on selection of benefit plan carriers, fiduciary duties, and liability for breach of fiduciary duty; exempts the Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund from the requirement to use the attorney general; increases the members of the board of trustees from ten to twelve and changes membership and terms; authorizes the board to retain an attorney who is independent of the attorney general as legal advisor; transfers the fund from the department of budget and finance to the department of human resources development. Requires biennial reports to the legislature. Sunsets on July 1, 2015.

SB 2175, SD1, HD1 (HSCR783-10) Status RELATING TO THE EMPLOYER-UNION HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST FUND.

LAB, FIN

Requires one trustee of the employer-union health benefits trust fund to be occupied by a representative appointed by the Hawaii council of mayors to represent county interests. Effective upon approval.

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SB 2884, SD2, HD1 (HSCR803-10) Status

## MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS.

LAB, FIN

Provides employer contribution amounts for Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund health benefit plan premiums in plan years 2009-2010 and 2010-2011 for employees of collective bargaining units (1) and (10) and their excluded counterparts. Effective upon its approval.
