DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

SB 2272 RELATING TO CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR NURSES. HTH, CPN

Testimony Requires nurses licensed in the state to complete 15 hours of continuing education during each two-year license period as a

requirement for license renewal.

SB 2207 RELATING TO MEDICAL RESIDENCY. HTH, CPN

Testimony
Status

Allows medical residents who are licensed to practice medicine in the Status of their medical residency program

hospitals or clinics.

SB 2163 RELATING TO THE PRACTICE OF NURSING. HTH, CPN

Testimony
Status

Defines the practice of nursing; directs the state board of nursing to adopt certain provisions of the NCSBN Model Nursing Practice Act and Model Nursing Administrative Rules; delineates the scope of practice for registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, and advanced

practice registered nurses; repeals Hawaii Administrative Rules relating to prescriptive authority for advanced practice registered

nurses.

SB 2188 RELATING TO DENTISTRY. HTH, CPN

<u>Testimony</u> Redefines the practice of dentistry to include teeth whitening. Status

SB 2126 RELATING TO DENTAL SERVICES. HTH, CPN

Testimony Prohibits a accident and health or sickness insurer, mutual benefit society, health maintenance organization, or dental service

society, health maintenance organization, or dental service organization from requiring a dentist who provides services to its subscribers to accept a fee set by the accident and health or sickness insurer, mutual benefit society, health maintenance organization, or dental service organization unless the services are covered under the

applicable subscriber agreement.

SB 2491 RELATING TO TELEMEDICINE. HTH, CPN Testimony Clarifies telehealth as a practice of medicine. Amends liability Status insurance provisions to allow for telehealth coverage under medical malpractice insurance. SB 2489 RELATING TO NATUROPATHIC MEDICINE. HTH, CPN **Testimony** Removes the authority of the board of naturopathic medicine to Status establish examination standards for minor office procedures and a naturopathic formulary. RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE SB 2469 HMS/HTH/JGO, **Testimony** FUND. WAM [Measure added 02-**Status** Appropriates moneys from the emergency and budget reserve fund to maintain levels of programs for education, human services, health. 04-10] SB 2474 RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR VIOLATIONS HMS/HTH, JGO **Testimony** INVOLVING MINORS. [Measure added 02-Status Establishes an immunity from prosecution for consumption of 05-101 intoxicating liquor by a minor if the minor summons medical treatment for another minor who requires such treatment as a result of consuming liquor. Also applies to the intoxicated minor and one or two other minors assisting summoning minor. SB 2692 RELATING TO THE STATE FISCAL STABILIZATION FUND. HMS/HTH, WAM Ensures funds are available for future fiscal emergencies by renaming [Measure added 02-**Testimony Status** and revising the Emergency Budget and Reserve Fund to create the 05-101 State Fiscal Stabilization Fund and requiring five percent of general fund end of year balances to be deposited into it. HMS/HTH, WAM **Testimony** Allows the Department of Human Services to improve the safety and [Measure added 02cost-effectiveness of psychotropic medication use. Status 05-10] SB 2806 RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE HMS/HTH, WAM **Testimony** FUND. [Measure added 02-05-10] **Status** Amends section 328L-3, HRS, to allow for moneys to be deposited from the excess general fund balance and amends 2009 session laws to prevent the total repeal of section 328L-3, HRS.

SB 2931 Testimony Status

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.

Requires the department of health to develop a four-year state plan reflecting plans relating to mental health and substance abuse service delivery in each geographic service area and specifically highlighting special populations. Requires the state council on mental health and substance abuse to review and comment on the plan. Directs the department of health to review and update the plan every four years. Directs the department of health to submit a draft of the plan to the legislature before the 2011 legislative session.
