Appropriates emergency funding to the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation to ensure the continuous delivery of critical health care services and for the payment of HHSC's operational costs, and establish the Big Island Rural Interdisciplinary Program in the East Hawaii region. <u>HB 2464, HD2</u> (HSCR484-10) <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PRACTICE OF PHARMACY. Amends the definition of "practice of pharmacy" by allowing immunizations to be administered to persons who are at least nine years of age with parental consent contingent upon the Governor's determination of a public health necessity. Effective July 1, 2020. (HB2464 HD2)	HTH, CPN
