SB 2148 Testimony Status	RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY. Appropriates funds to the Judiciary for FY 2010-2011.	JGO, WAM
SB 2157 Testimony Status	RELATING TO ADMINISTRATIVE LICENSE REVOCATION. Shifts costs of mailing administrative hearing request from the driver's license revocation office to the person requesting the hearing. Increases the administrative hearing fee from \$30 to \$50.	JGO, WAM
SB 2159 Testimony Status	RELATING TO TRAFFIC ABSTRACT FEE.  Increases the fee for a traffic abstract from \$7 to \$10 and increases the amount of the fee deposited into the general fund from \$5 to \$8.	JGO, WAM
SB 2161 Testimony Status	RELATING TO WITNESSES.  Increases the per diem payments for out-of-state witnesses in criminal cases from \$110 to \$145. Provides an additional \$90 per diem payment for witnesses from any island other than the island on which the court is located, when that witness is required to stay overnight.	JGO, WAM
SB 2454 Testimony Status	RELATING TO PUBLIC AGENCY MEETINGS AND RECORDS. Allows courts to charge fees for certified copies of pleadings, orders, transcripts, and other documents.	JGO, WAM
SB 2469 Testimony Status	RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND.  Appropriates moneys from the emergency and budget reserve fund to maintain levels of programs for education, human services, health.	HMS/HTH/JGO, WAM [Measure added 02- 04-10]
