Updates, organizes, and clarifies current campaign financing laws.

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCING.

Amends law relating to ballot issue committees. Defines automated phone call and requires certain information to be stated at the

beginning of such phone calls. Amends the definition of advertisement. Repeals the campaign spending commission's authority to adopt a code of fair campaign practices as part of its rules. Requires advertising notices and disclaimers to be included on every web page

that contains an advertisement.
