EBM, WLO, JUD

(HSCR889-10) Status

Prohibits the harvest, possession, sale, or distribution of a shark or shark parts unless landed whole and harvested under a commercial marine license. Prohibits under Hawaii Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, possession or sale of shark fins. Effective July

1, 2050. (SB2169 HD2)
