WTL

Requires the Kaneohe Bay Regional Council to meet annually instead **Testimony** of quarterly and to report on its activities annually instead of semiannually. Repeals the sunset of the Council scheduled for 7/1/2010. **Status**

SB 2547 RELATING TO SMALL BOAT HARBORS. WTL

Requires small boat harbor commercial vessel permittees who, in the **Testimony** course of providing an excursion between state boating facilities, disembark fare-paying passengers with the expectation that they will **Status** enter upon any public or quasi-public real property during the course of their excursion, to comply with all rules and regulations applicable to these areas.

SB 2914 RELATING TO THE BUREAU OF CONVEYANCES. WTL

Requires registrar to provide adjoining landowner, upon request, any **Testimony** information of record relating to the management, control, and title of any public highway, waterway, or water course.

SB 492 RELATING TO WATER. WTL

Proposed SD1: Proposed SD1

Requires that the commission on water resource management include one member from each county and that at least one member be a **Testimony**

farmer. (SD1)
