Chair Ige, and Members of the Committee:

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your time in considering my nomination by Governor Lingle to be appointed to the Board of Health. I believe that through this appointment I will be able to continue and further my ongoing work towards improving the health outcomes of the citizens of Hawaii.

For the past 15 years I have worked as a Partnership Program Coordinator for the National Cancer Institute's Cancer Information Service at the University of Hawai'i Cancer Research Center. My job, and my mission, is to disseminate the latest knowledge in cancer control to the public. I work to accomplish this by providing methods of liaise between researchers and the broader community.

To this end I have worked in concert with many of Hawai'i's public health and human service organizations including the Hawai'i Department of Health, the University of Hawai'i Department of Public Health Studies, the American Cancer Society, the Coalition for Tobacco Free Hawai'i, the Hawai'i Medical Association, and various medical care facilities in the state.

Current I am continuing my role in cancer control education and partnership, working as a staff member for the University of Hawai'i Cancer Research Center, while pursuing my Doctorate in Community-participatory and Translational Research at the University of Hawai'i.
