been an advisory board member for the Missing Child Center, Mothers Against Drunk Driving, and the Sex Abuse Treatment Center. Mr. Dunn has also served on the Kailua Neighborhood Board and several other boards and commissions.

Under Act 93 (SLH 2009), Hawaii joined the new Interstate Compact for Juveniles. Act 93 (SLH 2009), also established a state-level council, known as the State Council for the Interstate Compact for Juveniles. Act 93 (SLH 2009), requires the gubernatorial appointment of a compact administrator and victim advocate for the State Council.

Act 93 (SLH 2009), places the State Council for the Interstate Compact for Juveniles administratively under the judiciary. The Judiciary supports the appointment of Mr. Dunn as the victim advocate for the State Council for the Interstate Compact for Juveniles and feels that Mr. Dunn's experience and knowledge will be a valuable asset.
