With my 40 years of farming experience, I bring my "school of hard knocks" logic to the board. I have experience with livestock, orchard, and vegetable farming and know first-hand the challenges that the farming community face.

Having participated in the Agriculture Leadership Foundation of Hawai'i (ALFH), Agriculture Leadership Program, as a member and graduate of Class VIII, I feel I enhanced my skills in facilitation and the ability to work collaboratively within our community. This training program has provided me a state-wide perspective of agriculture. A large part of the program involved traveling to neighbor-island, networking with others in the agricultural community, and learning about the common challenges we all share.

As an Agricultural Research Technician with the College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources (CTAHR) I understand the science behind the various challenges that farmers encounter. I also understand how important research is in developing crops that can help us compete in the global marketplace.

4. What do you hope to accomplish during your term of service?

I would like to see the State Agricultural Lands and irrigation systems transferred to HDOA. These lands and facilities should be managed by entities that have the expertise and experience in managing these lands.

Experience: 40+ years of farming in Hawai'i, 20 years with the (CTAHR).

6. Name one previous experience that would make you stand out. How would this benefit the Board of Agriculture?

In 2000, the Līhu'e Plantation Company announced that they were ceasing agricultural operations. This meant that the East Kaua'i Water Company, which delivered water to the plantation as well as to farmers and ranchers on the east side of Kaua'i, would cease to exist. The water system, which was built by the plantation but is owned by the State of Hawai'i, would have fallen into disrepair.

Farmers and ranchers who used the system formed the East Kaua'i User's Cooperative. In 2002, after two years of hard work, the Co-op was issued a permit from DLNR to operate the system. During this same year, I was elected President of the Co-op and still serve in that capacity.

This is a good example of public/private partnership that may serve as a model for state-owned irrigation systems. I played a leadership role in the formation of this Co-op and I continue to serve this important partnership not only as a leader but from within the farming community.

7. Can you foresee any possible conflicts of interests that could arise during your service on the Board of Agriculture? How would you overcome any possible conflicts of interest?

No, I do not foresee any conflicts of interest as a board member. If any unforeseen conflicts arise I would declare any bias and abstain from the final vote. My service to the agricultural community is voluntary with no personal or monetary gain.


