Chair Taniguchi, Vice Chair Takamine and Members of the Committee:

The Downtown Neighborhood Board strongly supported HB 1863, as introduced, removing the June 30, 2010 sunset date for Act 192, SLH 2008. We prefer total removal of the sunset rather than just extending it two years to 2012, as provided in HD 1.

Act 192 is an effective measure providing that a person convicted for the third time of soliciting prostitution within a ten-year period is considered to have committed the offense of “habitual solicitation of prostitution” and the offense becomes a misdemeanor rather than another petty misdemeanor. The potential penalty is thus significantly stronger in deterring future offenses.

We urge the committee to consider adding the language in HB 1867 to this bill. That bill, which was deferred by the House Judiciary Committee, would have made it a misdemeanor to solicit prostitution within 750 feet of a school or public park.

These actions, taken together, would go far in cutting back on the incidences of prostitution that occur on a daily basis in our neighborhood. Our experience in the Downtown and China town areas is that prostitution is frequently not the “victimless crime” that some would have us believe. Prostitution is often glamorized and made to seem just the inevitable product of our sexual proclivity.

We know from direct evidence in our neighborhood that other crimes spring from the prostitution activity. These include murder, assault, robbery and violence against women. Those who control the activities of the prostitutes are often engaged in trafficking both drugs and the women they procure.

This measure, if amended to eliminate the sunset date and especially if the penalty for solicitation near a park or school is added, would ensure that one of the most effective efforts to reduce the broad evils of prostitution would continue to be a strong deterrent. If those who solicit prostitution are punished, as are the prostitutes themselves, we hope that these activities will diminish and we can once again move freely on the streets of our neighborhood.



All of us would be much better off if we looked rationally at these issues instead of continually turning to the police to solve social problems they are not well equipped to deal with.

We recommend this bill be amended by gutting its contents and replacing them with SB2854. Senate Bill 2854 would allow the counties to set up zones for the types of problems HB#1863 has been unable to solve.



My name is Michael Lakey and I am the General Manager at Kukui Plaza on 1255 Nuuanu Street. Thank you for this opportunity to testify in strong support of HB 1863 and HB 1867 to do something about prostitution in our neighborhood.

For many years prostitution and its related criminal activity has posed a threat to families and individuals that live in the Kukui Plaza. As the general manager of Kukui Plaza, it is my job to help keep our residents safe. At this point, we are doing all we can, but the scope of the problem is larger than we alone can solve. We need legislators to step in and help make our community safer.

Many of our residents are afraid to walk on our block in the evening for fear of harassment and sexual solicitations from prostitutes walking on our streets. These incidents occur even in front of our residents' children. In July 2006, a related disagreement led to a person being murdered right outside of our facility, outside our residents' homes.

We have implemented numerous security measures to rid our area of prostitutes, including every recommendation made by the Honolulu Police Department. We increased exterior lighting and installed additional security cameras. We conduct special security patrols on an hourly basis to report criminal activity to police, and our residents perform weekly citizens' patrols in an attempt to take back our streets.

Unfortunately, these activities are not enough because when individuals are arrested for dealing in prostitution, the penalties are nothing to them. They come right back to our streets.


We need you to hear and pass HB1863 and HB1867. The passing of these bills will provide one more step to help deter this activity and remind everyone that prostitution is illegal in Hawaii.

Kukui Plaza was built 30 years ago and some of our residents have lived here the entire time. I ask you to imagine that one day your neighborhood is filled with prostitutes on your streets. Then imagine a murder as a result.

Please take this issue seriously. Our management and residents have worked well with the Honolulu Police Department, but as we've seen with other tragedies in our state, sometimes it is the law that needs to be improved when everyone else is already doing all they can.
