## TESTIMONY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

March 29, 2010

HOUSE BILL NO. 2835

COMMITTEE ON WATER, LAND, AGRICULTURE AND HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS

The Department of Transportation opposes this bill, because we believe it will cause undue hardship and take an extraordinary amount of time to accurately research, identify and provide available ownership information for highways, roads, lanes, alleys and streams. There are no known existing available databases at the Bureau of Conveyances for this bill.

This bill states that ownership cannot be readily determined by search of public records. Ownership is typically determined by exhausted searches of public records and maps. Even with the ample amount of time and research, ownership of these interests might be hard to determine. Some of the ownership of said roads and streams are determined by older maps that have no transfer ownership documents of record. Common use does not ascertain a land or waterway as a legal owner. We believe that the Bureau does not have this capability (Refer also past Bills, ie. 2008 HB 2418, HB 3415, SB 2900 and 2009 HB 932, HB 021, BH 640, HB 1702, HB 832 and SB 0399).

Examples given were: Waiohino subdivision which did not indicate ownership for an access road that has been widely used for years and plantation roads of Ka'u on the Big Island are often utilized without determination of ownership. It should be noted that simple use by the public does not give the users legal ownership.

The current and still recommended approach is to have the interested owners do their own due diligence when presented with a situation. The bill will likely have a negative effect on other agencies beyond the Bureau.

#### In consideration of HOUSE BILL 2835 RELATING TO THE BUREAU OF CONVEYANCES

House Bill 2835 would require the registrar of the Bureau of Conveyances to provide adjacent landowners with any information available concerning ownership of roads and streams adjoining their lands. The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) does not support this measure as the Department believes that the Registrar of the Bureau of Conveyances is in no position to opine on the "management" or "control" of public highways, waterway or water courses.
