TESTIMONY OF LEIMOMI KHAN, PRESIDENT IN SUPPORT OF

HCR 103 and HR 54, EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR AND URGING PARTICIPATION IN THE 6^{TH} HEALING OUR SPIRIT WORLDWIDE GATHERING WITH AMENDMENT

Aloha Chairperson Carroll, Vice Chairperson Shimabukuro, and members of the Committee on Hawaiian Affairs,

Thank you for this opportunity to testify in support of HCR 103 and HR 54, Expressing Support for and Urging Participation in the 6th Healing Our Spirit Worldwide Gathering.

Papa Ola Lokahi is hosting this year's 6th Healing our Spirit Worldwide Gathering in Hawaii, which is expected to attract at least 4,000 participants from around the world. It is a rare opportunity to have this honor that brings indigenous peoples from all over the world to our home, a Hawaiian culture rich with healing methods, such as Hawaiian medicinal plants, lomi lomi, the natural healing powers of the sun and sea, ho'oponopono, special diets, etc. We fully support their efforts and wish to encourage national and state agencies to support and promote the "Gathering". To these ends, we recommend the following amendments to the resolution:

- 7th Whereas Delete in its entirety. While the AHCC is committed to fully supporting the Healing Our Spirit Worldwide Gathering, there are many other organizations who have volunteered their support. Thus, we believe it better that we not be singled out.
- 8th Whereas, change to read: "Whereas, indigenous peoples from around the world will be attending the 6th Healing Our Spirit Worldwide Gathering;"
- 9th Whereas, added, "Whereas, the Hawaiian culture is rich in healing methods, such as Hawaiian medicinal plants, lomi lomi, ho'oponopono, and the natural healing powers of the sun and sea;"
- 10th Whereas added, "Whereas, the 6th Healing Our Spirit Worldwide Gathering provides an opportunity for Hawaii to share its rich Hawaiian and diverse culture;"

Second Be It Resolved clause concerning distribution of this resolution, expand to include the following: "Hawaii State Department of Education, Department of Health, and the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism; the University of Hawaii, John A Burns School of Medicine; the University of Hawaii Kamakakuokalani Center for Hawaiian Studies; the Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health Center; the Office of Hawaiian Affairs; the United States Department of Health and Human Services; and the US Office of Minority Health." It would be really nice, too, if a copy of the resolution was sent to every state Dept of Health, especially those with large indigenous populations.

We urge passage of resolution HCR 103 and HR 54 with these amendments.

Aloha Chair Carroll, Vice Chair Shimabukuro and Members of the Committee on Hawaiian Affairs. Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony in strong support of HCR 103/HR 54.

First, we would like to thank the Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs (AHCC) under the leadership of Mrs. Leimomi Khan who has participated with us from the beginning to make the upcoming Sixth Gathering of Healing Our Spirit Worldwide (HOSW) the landmark happening that it will be not only for the Native Hawaiian community but for all who call Hawai'i home. We support the proposed amendments made by the AHCC in its testimony.

The HOSW movement began almost 20 years ago in an effort to address long-standing health issues in Indigenous peoples around the world. The important thing about this is that it was Indigenous leadership that this took the initiative from the World Health Organization to launch this effort. The Gathering is held once every four years and hosted by a different Indigenous Peoples in a different nation. To date the First Nations, Metis, and Inuit from Canada; American Indians/Alaska Natives from the United States; Maori from Aotearoa (New Zealand); and Aborigine from Australia have hosted this event; and now it's the time for Kanaka Maoli from Hawai'i Nei to do likewise.

Papa Ola Lokahi (POL)'s role has been as a facilitator for the Sixth Gathering. In truth it has been and continues to be the work of many hands under the direction of Vicky Holt-Takamine and her staff which is making this event possible. Besides the AHCC, POL

needs to expressly thank the Office of Hawaiian Affairs, Queen Liliu`okalani Children's Center, the Hawai`i Convention Center and many others for all their ongoing support.

With this resolution goes an invitation to all of Hawai'i's people who are interested to participate in this once in a lifetime event. We would ask them to visit the Gathering's website at www.hosw.com for more information. We also look forward to having members of Hawai'i's Legislature and state and county governments come and participate.

Thank you for this opportunity to testify in strong support of HCR 103 and HR 54, Supporting Papa Ola Lokahi to facilitate the 6th Healing Our Spirit Worldwide Gathering Scheduled for September 3-10, 2010 at the Hawai'i Convention Center and other venues throughout the state.

Indigenous peoples from all over the world are invited once every four years to gather at a Healing Our Spirit Worldwide gathering, an indigenous cultural celebration focusing on common issues, wise practices, and successes in health, healing, and addictions within indigenous communities. This movement was founded almost 20 years ago, and since then, such gatherings have been hosted by First Nations people of Canada, the Aborigine of Australia, Maori of Aotearoa, and American Indians and Alaska Natives of the United States.

In 2006, Papa Ola Lokahi, the Native Hawaiian health board, was asked to facilitate participation of Kanaka Maoli, the indigenous peoples of Hawai'i, at the 5th Healing Our Spirit Worldwide Gathering in Edmonton, Canada. More than 75 Kanaka Maoli participated at the 5th gathering, which provided the impetus for Kanaka Maoli to support and host the 6th gathering in Hawai'i.

We appreciate and acknowledge Papa Ola Lokahi for its successes on Native Hawaiian health issues and for its good work to facilitate the 6th Healing Our Spirit Worldwide Gathering.
