I am writing to you in regards in objection to large motor homes or RV vehicles from coming to Hawaii from the mainland. Because Hawaii is an island, I feel that we have no room or space for these large motor homes to live here.

In the past we have had a number of problems of 2 motor homes parked at Sandy Beach and Hawaii Kai boat ramp. I have made numerous calls to the HPD and they informed me that all they could do was move every 24 hours. Apparently, there is no state law that prohibits them from parking or living at beaches.

We have had 2 of these 40 foot motor home obstructing views from our beaches at Waimanalo and Hawaii Kai. Because there is no law prohibiting these large vehicles from existing on our beaches, therefore, I am in support of this House Concurrent Resolution 254 and House Resolution 182.
