HCR 316/HR 231 -- APPROVING THE FEE SIMPLE SALE OF NON-CEDED LANDS HELD BY THE UNIVERISTY OF HAWAI'I IN KAPOLEI, HAWAI'I

Chairs Ito and Chang, Vice Chairs Har and Nakashima, and Members of the House Committees on Water, Land and Ocean Resources and Higher Education:

The University of Hawai`i – West O`ahu, supports the passage of HCR 316/HR 231. These measures would allow the University of Hawai`i to sell in fee simple certain nonceded lands adjoining the site of the proposed UH – West O`ahu Kapolei campus. The proceeds from the sale of lands would be used to finance future construction of the new campus.

These measures would afford the University the flexibility to proceed in a timely and efficient manner to take advantage of opportunities to raise revenues through the sale of its non-ceded lands, as market conditions and needs may warrant. We appreciate the intent of the measures which recognize UH – West Oʻahu's need to comply with the Campbell land covenants, to raise funds to finance the future construction of its new campus and to expedite procedural requirements of Act 176 that could delay the effective sale of its lands in support of the campus development.

HCR 316, APPROVING THE FEE SIMPLE SALE OF NON-CEDED LANDS HELD BY THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII IN KAPOLEI, HAWAII

The Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA) offers the following comments on HCR 316:

We are concerned that this concurrent resolution does not provide evidence that the lands in question are in fact non-ceded lands. Moreover, the lands are simply described as "non-ceded lands owned by the University of Hawaii situated around the Kapolei campus." This vague description, lacking TMKs or other precise identifiers, makes it difficult to determine whether the lands are ceded.

In addition, the vague description does not appear to satisfy the requirement in Act 176, SLH 2009, that concurrent resolutions of this nature must identify the location and area of the parcels of land to be sold. Other information required by Act 176 is also missing, such as the appraisal value of the land to be sold.

We wish to note that OHA's concerns about this concurrent resolution do not signify any change in OHA's support of House Bill 2561 Relating to Lands Controlled by the State. That bill seeks statutory amendments to make the legislative oversight prescribed by Act 176 apply only to ceded lands.
