This measure, among other things, proposes to increases the liquor tax on all alcoholic beverage varieties. This measure also creates a new special fund for purposes of funding early intervention services.

The Department of Taxation (Department) opposes this measure as a tax increase.

The Department does not support the tax increase in this measure. Notwithstanding the merit of raising revenue for early intervention services, the Department does not support tax increases, especially during the current economy when taxpayers cannot afford tax increases.

Moreover, regardless of the merit of the special fund proposed in this legislation, the Department cannot support a tax increase of this kind to be deposited into a special fund. Any sin tax increase this session must be deposited to the benefit of the general fund. Early intervention services should be prioritized with other government services that are funded out of the general fund.

As a technical matter, the Department suggests deleting the tax rates from 1997-1998 to clean up the statute.

This measure will result in approximately \$1.9 million to the special fund.
