- 1 **Department's Position:** Oppose.
- 2 **Fiscal Implications:** Undetermined resources are required that are not in the current budget.
- 3 Purpose and Justification: This proposal establishes a temporary emergency vehicle noise task force
- 4 to determine the impact of the use of emergency vehicle sirens relative to noise and their effect on public
- safety as well as the effectiveness of using emergency lights instead of sirens during nighttime hours.
- We appreciate the intent of the proposal to minimize emergency vehicle noise while maintaining
- 7 safety in traffic. However, our current budget precludes the support required to implement the proposed
- 8 task force.
- 9 Furthermore, we note that a priority dispatch has already been implemented to determine when
- warning lights and sirens are appropriate; this item is mentioned in section (b)(3) on page 3 of the bill.
