Dear Senator Tsutsui:

Pursuant to section 52D-3.5 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, Reports to Legislature, we are submitting our 2010 annual report to the Legislature. The report includes a summary of the facts, the nature of the misconduct for each incident which resulted in the suspension or discharge of a police officer, and the disciplinary action imposed. The report also indicates the number of police officers suspended and discharged during 2010 under the following categories of our department's Standards of Conduct.

- 1. Malicious Use of Physical Force
- 2. Mistreatment of Prisoners
- 3. Use of Drugs and Narcotics
- 4. Cowardice

It should be noted that the enclosed summary covers each individual incident for which discipline was meted out by the department. Out of that total number, an officer may have been involved in more than one incident and disciplined more than once.

It should also be noted that the discipline meted out in a case is dependent upon the past disciplinary record of the officer. For example, discipline for an officer who has been disciplined recently for the same or similar violation would be more severe than for an officer who has a spotless disciplinary record.
