Pursuant to Act 242, relating to Uniform Information Practices, during the calendar year 2010, the Department <u>did not</u> suspend any Police Officer for:

- 1. Malicious use of physical force;
- 2. Mistreatment of a prisoner / arrested person;
- 3. Use and/or possession of drugs and/or narcotics; or
- 4. Cowardice.

Attached is a summary of all incidents and violations of Department Policies and Procedures which resulted in the suspension or discharge of Police Officers during the period from January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010, with the following comments:

- While not specified, discipline imposed may be progressive, whereby the prior disciplinary history of an employee is considered.
- The discipline imposed may have been subsequently amended as a result of the Collective Bargaining Agreement grievance process.
