## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

### PART I

2 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended for immediate passage
3 in accordance with section 9 of Article VII of the Constitution
4 of the State of Hawaii.

5 SECTION 2. There are appropriated or authorized from the 6 sources of funding indicated below to make health care premium 7 payments (BUF 761) in the following sums, or so much thereof as 8 may be necessary, to fund for fiscal biennium 2009-2011 the 9 Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund costs contained in the agreement negotiated with the exclusive bargaining 10 11 representative of collective bargaining units 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 12 7, 8, 9, 10, and 13:
