A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.

SECTION 2. The purpose of this Act is to amend Act 191,
Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, which appropriated moneys from the
emergency and budget reserve fund to maintain the levels of
programs determined to be essential to education, public health,
and public welfare for fiscal year 2010-2011.

9 The existing language of certain appropriations in Act 191 10 makes it difficult to carry out the legislature's intent to 11 award moneys to specific organizations. This Act provides 12 technical corrections to Act 191 to permit the awarding of 13 moneys to specified organizations and extends the lapse date of 14 Act 191's appropriations from June 30, 2011, to June 30, 2012. 15 SECTION 3. Act 191, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, is

16 amended as follows:

17 1. By adding a new section to read:

1	"SECTION 24A. There is appropriated out of the emergency
2	and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
3	\$1,900,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
4	year 2010-2011 as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii
5	Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Primary Care Association for
6	adult dental care provided at federally qualified health
7	centers; provided that the funds shall not be used for any other
8	purpose. The governor is authorized to use enhanced federal
9	medical assistance percentages funds to offset the amount
10	appropriated; provided that the total amount shall not exceed
11	\$1,900,000. The department of human services shall prepare a
12	report on:
13	(1) The number of adults receiving these benefits;
14	(2) The cost per person;
15	(3) The total breakdown of administrative costs and other
16	overhead costs; and
17	(4) Statistics, if available, on how this dental program
18	is reducing the number of emergency dental-related
19	medical procedures;
20	provided that the department of human services shall submit its
21	report to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
22	convening of the regular session of 2012.

1	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2	human services for the purposes of this Act."
3	2. By adding two new sections to read:
4	"SECTION 40A. There is appropriated out of the emergency
5	and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
6	\$100,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
7	2010-2011 for Maui community college, University of Hawaii, for
8	the adult dental care program.
9	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
10	human services for the purposes of this Act.
11	SECTION 40B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance of any
12	appropriation made by this Act as of the close of business on
13	June 30, 2011, shall not lapse; provided that all moneys from
14	the appropriations that are unencumbered as of June 30, 2012,
15	shall lapse to the emergency and budget reserve fund."
16	SECTION 4. Act 191, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, is
17	amended as follows:
18	1. By amending section 12 to read:
19	"SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the emergency
20	and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
21	\$332,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
22	2010-2011 as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised
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1	Statutes, for the Waianae District Comprehensive Health and
2	Hospital Board, Incorporated to support its emergency room
3	services.
4	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
5	health for the purposes of this Act."
6	2. By amending section 16 to read:
7	"SECTION 16. There is appropriated out of the emergency
8	and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
9	\$500,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
10	2010-2011 as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revisèd
11	Statutes, for Kokua Kalihi Valley Comprehensive Family Services.
12	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
13	health for the purposes of this Act."
14	3. By amending sections 18 and 19 to read:
15	"SECTION 18. There is appropriated out of the emergency
16	and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
17	\$200,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
18	2010-2011 as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised
19	Statutes, for the Windward Oahu Spouse Abuse Shelter.
20	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
21	human services for the purposes of this Act.

1	SECTION 19. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
2	budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000
3	or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011
4	as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for
5	the Blueprint for Change Program for Neighborhood Place Walk-in
6	Centers.
7	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
8	human services for the purposes of this Act."
9	4. By amending sections 21 and 22 to read:
10	"SECTION 21. There is appropriated out of the emergency
11	and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
12	\$762,500 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
13	2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F,
14	Hawaii Revised Statutes, to support domestic violence shelters
15	statewide $[-]$ and to be distributed as follows:
-16	(1) Child and Family Service
17	(A) Two shelters on Oahu \$206,429
18	(B) Two shelters on Hawaii Island \$206,429
19	(2) Parents and Children Together \$103,214
20	(3) Women Helping Women \$103,214
21	(4) Molokai Community Service Council, Inc. \$40,000

1	(5) Young Women's Christian Association
2	(YWCA) of Kauai \$103,214
3	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
4	human services for the purposes of this Act."
5	SECTION 22. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
6	budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$210,000
7	for fiscal year 2010-2011 as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F,
8	Hawaii Revised Statutes, for the Hale Mahaolu for personal care
9	services.
10	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
11	human services for the purposes of this Act."
12	5. By amending section 30 to read:
13	"SECTION 30. There is appropriated out of the emergency
14	and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
15	\$200,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
16	2010-2011 as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised
17	Statutes, to Adult Friends for Youth for youth gang prevention
18	and intervention services.
19	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
20	human services for the purposes of this Act."
21	6. By amending sections 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36 to read:

1 "SECTION 32. There is appropriated out of the emergency 2 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of 3 \$200,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 4 2010-2011 as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised 5 Statutes, for Volunteer Legal Services Hawaii to provide pro bono legal services for indigent persons. 6 7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for 8 the purposes of this Act." 9 SECTION 33. There is appropriated out of the emergency and 10 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$720,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 11 as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for 12 13 the Legal Aid Society of Hawaii to provide general civil legal services. 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for 15 the purposes of this Act. 16 SECTION 34. There is appropriated out of the emergency and 17 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$282,000 18 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 19 as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for 20 the Hawaii Family Law Clinic to provide services to obtain 21 temporary restraining orders. 22

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1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for 2 the purposes of this Act. 3 SECTION 35. There is appropriated out of the emergency and 4 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$150,000 5 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for 6 7 Catholic Charities Hawaii to provide intra-familial sex assault 8 treatment services. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for 9 10 the purposes of this Act. 11 SECTION 36. There is appropriated out of the emergency and 12 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$150,000 13 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for 14 the Children's Alliance of Hawaii, Inc., to provide child sex 15 assault treatment services. 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for 17 the purposes of this Act." 18

19 7. By amending sections 38 and 39 to read:

20 "SECTION 38. There is appropriated out of the emergency
21 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
22 \$75,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year

1	2010-2011 as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised
2	Statutes, to the [YMCA] Young Men's Christian Association of
3	Honolulu for the Weed and Seed Program.
4	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
5	labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.
6	SECTION 39. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
7	budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$466,000
8	or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011
9 .	as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for
10	the Kapiolani Medical Center for Women and Children for the sex
11	abuse treatment center for statewide sex assault treatment
12	services.
13	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
14	the attorney general for the purposes of this Act."
15	SECTION 5. Act 191, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010 is amended
16	by repealing section 24:
17	["SECTION-24. There is appropriated out of the emergency
18	and budget reserve-fund of the State of Hawaii for QUEST health
19	care payments, the sum of \$2,000,000 or so much thereof as may
20	be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 for the restoration of
21	adult-dental care formerly-granted under-program ID HMS-245-
22	QUEST-health care payments; provided that the funds-shall-not-be
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1	expended for any other purpose. The governor is authorized to
2	utilize enhanced federal-medical-assistance percentages-(FMAP)-
3	funds-to-offset the amount appropriated, provided that the total
4	amount shall not exceed \$2,000,000. Any unexpended funds shall
5	lapse to their respective funds.
6	The department of human services shall prepare a report on:
7	(1) The number of adults receiving these benefits;
8	(2) The cost per person;
9	(3) Total breakdown of administrative costs and other
10	overhead-costs; and
11	(4) Statistics, if available, of how this dental program
12	is reducing the number of emergency-dental-related
13	medical procedures;
14	provided further that the department of human services shall
15	submit the report to the legislature no later than twenty days
16	prior to the convening of the 2011 regular session.
17	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
18	human services for the purposes of this Act."]
19	SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
20	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
21	SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
