

A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION OUT OF THE BROWNFIELDS CLEANUP
REVOLVING LOAN FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.

4 SECTION 2. A critical funding emergency exists. The
5 department of business, economic development, and tourism
6 received a grant of \$2,000,000 from the federal Environmental
7 Protection Agency for a brownfields cleanup revolving loan
8 program to clean up contaminated sites. Funds under this grant
9 must be disbursed by the end of fiscal year 2010-2011. The
10 department of business, economic development, and tourism
11 executed a loan with the department of Hawaiian home lands to
12 clean up a contaminated site in Kapolei. Funds must be
13 disbursed to the department of Hawaiian home lands in fiscal
14 year 2010-2011. The existing ceiling of the brownfields cleanup
15 revolving loan fund is \$1,000,000. However, the funds that need
16 to be disbursed exceed \$1,000,000. Therefore, an appropriation
17 increase to \$2,000,000 out of the brownfields cleanup revolving



1 loan fund is needed before the end of the fiscal year. This
 2 emergency appropriation is necessary in order for the State to
 3 address this shortfall.

4 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate additional moneys
 5 out of the brownfields cleanup revolving loan fund in order to
 6 complete the disbursement of funds to the department of Hawaiian
 7 home lands in fiscal year 2010-2011.

8 SECTION 3. Act 162, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, as
 9 amended by Act 180, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, is amended by
 10 amending item K-3 of section 3 to read as follows:



 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

19 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
