BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

5	fund; established. (a) There is hereby established in the
6	state treasury a special fund known as the conservation and
7	resources enforcement special fund, which shall be administered
8	by the department.
9	(b) The following shall be deposited into the conservation
10	and resources enforcement special fund:
11	(1) Grants, awards, donations, gifts, transfers, or moneys
12	derived from public or private sources for the
13	purposes of enforcing the provisions of title 12;
14	chapters 6D, 6E, and 6K; or any rule adopted
15	thereunder;
16	(2) Fees, reimbursements, administrative charges, and

18	(d)	The fund shall be held separate and apart from all
19	other mon	eys, funds, and accounts in the department, except that
20	any money	s received from the federal government or from private
21	contribut	ions shall be deposited and accounted for in accordance
22	with cond	itions established by the department and agencies or
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1	persons from whom the moneys are received. Any balance
2	remaining in the fund at the end of any fiscal year shall be
3	carried forward in the fund for the next fiscal year.
4	(e) As used in this section, "department" means the
5	department of land and natural resources."
6	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the conservation
7	and resources enforcement special fund the sum of \$250,000 or so
8	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 for
9	the purposes of covering expenses related to enforcing natural,
10	cultural, and historic-resources protection laws and rules.
11	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
12	land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
13	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
