A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EVIDENCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 210, Session 2 Laws of Hawaii 2008 (Act 210), established a limited news media 3 privilege against the compelled disclosure of sources and unpublished information to a legislative, executive, or judicial 4 5 officer or body, or to any other person who may compel testimony. Act 210 is scheduled to be repealed on June 30, 6 7 2011. The purpose of this Act is to extend the news media 8 privilege to June 30, 2013. 9 10 SECTION 2. Act 210, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, is 11 amended by amending section 3 to read as follows: 12 "SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval 13 and shall be repealed on June 30, [2011.] 2013." SECTION 3. The judiciary, through its standing committee 14 15 on rules of evidence, shall report to the legislature no later 16 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2012, the following information or recommendations: 17
