## A BILL FOR AN ACT

ACT 128

H.D. 1 C.D. 1

RELATING TO SPECIAL EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Pursuant to the federal Individuals with 2 Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004 and chapter 60 of 3 the Hawaii administrative rules, the department of education is 4 required to provide to students who are eligible to receive special education and related services an array of placements in 5 6 the least-restrictive environment. At times, private special education schools and programs provide at the department's 7 8 expense placement opportunities for students with disabilities who are eligible to receive special education and related 9 10 services.

11 The purpose of this Act is to provide definitions of 12 various private special education schools and programs and the 13 requirements for those schools and programs to accept students 14 with disabilities at the department's expense.

15 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
17 and to read as follows:

3	accreditation. (a) As used in this section:			
.4	"Accredited private special education school or program"			
5	means a private day school, private day program, or any			
6	preschool that has earned accreditation according to the			
7	requirements and procedures specified by the Western Association			
8	of Schools and Colleges, any Hawaii affiliate of the Western			
9	Association of Schools and Colleges, the Hawaii Association of			
10	Independent Schools, the National Association for the Education			
11	of Young Children, or the National Early Childhood Program for			
12	Accreditation.			
13	"Certified or licensed private residential facility" means			
14	a private residential school or program that has earned			
15	licensure, certification, or accreditation according to			
16	requirements and procedures specified by the appropriate state			
17	licensure board or department.			
18	"Nonpublic special education school or program" means any			
19	privately owned or operated preschool, school, educational			
20	organization or corporation, treatment facility, day program,			
21	residential program, or any other placement that maintains,			
22	conducts, or provides classes or programming, including related			
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1	services as defined by federal or state laws, rules, or
2	regulations, for the purpose of offering instruction or
3	treatment to students with disabilities for consideration,
4	profit, tuition, or fees.
5	(b) Any accredited private special education school or
6	program, certified or licensed private residential facility, or
7	nonpublic special education school or program that:
8	(1) Provides education, treatment, programming, or related
9	services to students with disabilities who are
10	eligible to receive special education and related
11	services pursuant to federal or state laws, rules, or
12	regulations; and
13	(2) Receives funding from the State, either directly or
14	through parental reimbursement,
15	shall comply with all federal and state laws, rules, and
16	regulations.
17	(c) Any nonpublic special education school or program
18	that:
19	(1) Is not accredited by the Western Association of

4	(2)	Receives funding from the State, either directly or		
5		through parental reimbursement,		
6	shall app	ly for accreditation within ninety days from the date		
7	of accepting a student with disabilities who was placed there as			
8	the resul	t of a hearing officer's decision pursuant to section		
9	302A-443,	court order, settlement agreement, or placement by the		
10	departmen	t. Within the ninety-day application period, the		
11	nonpublic	special education school or program shall provide		
12	proof of	its application for accreditation to the department.		
13	(d)	The department may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91		
14	to implem	ent this section."		
15	SECT	ION 3. New statutory material is underscored.		
16	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
