A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTIO	ON 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide
2	procurement	authority to semi-autonomous county public transit
3	agencies, i	ncluding the agency known as the Honolulu authority
4	for rapid t	transportation, to allow them to function as semi-
5	autonomous	agencies of their respective counties.
6	SECTIO	ON 2. Section 103D-203, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7	amended by	amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows:

7	provided	that the chief procurement officers designated under

10	the respective county's charter, ordinances, or rules adopted in		
11	accordance with chapter 91.		
12	(c)	For purposes of applying this chapter to the	
13	judiciary	, houses of the legislature, office of Hawaiian	
14	affairs, University of Hawaii, department of education,		
15	remaining departments of the executive branch and all		
16	governmental bodies administratively attached to them, and the		
17	several counties, unless otherwise expressly provided, "State"		
18	shall mean "judiciary", "state senate", "state house of		
19	representatives", "office of Hawaiian affairs", "University of		
20	Hawaii", "department of education", "executive branch",		
21	"county",	[and] "board of water supply"[7] or "department of	

- water supply", and "semi-autonomous public transit agency", 1
- 2 respectively."
- SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 3
- and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011. 5
