A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RECONSTITUTING SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Public schools that have been in restructuring
 for four or more years and have not made significant
 advancements toward improving academic performance, should be
 reconstituted using extraordinary measures. Drastic steps must
 be taken to ensure that our students make adequate academic
 progress.

7 The purpose of this Act is to allow the superintendent of 8 education to:

9 (1) Reconstitute a public school, except for a charter
10 school, after certain considerations have been made,
11 that has been in restructuring for four or more school
12 years and has not made significant advancements toward
13 improving academic performance; and

14 (2) Recommend to the charter school review panel actions
15 that should be taken to reconstitute a charter school
16 that has been in restructuring for four or more school
17 years or recommend that the charter school's charter
18 be revoked.



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1 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 ''§302A-Reconstituting schools. (a) Notwithstanding 5 collective bargaining agreements, memorandums of agreement, or 6 memorandums of understanding, the superintendent may reconstitute a public school, except a charter school, that has 7 been in restructuring under the No Child Left Behind Act of 8 9 2001, Public Law 107-110, for four or more school years and has 10 not made significant advancements toward improving academic performance as determined by a statistical analysis of academic 11 12 data; provided that the following have been considered: Student proficiency in reading and math in the period 13 (1) 14 during which the school is in restructuring; Interventions and other programs being used by the 15 (2)school to address student proficiency; 16 The number of highly qualified or effective teachers 17 (3) 18 at the school; 19 (4) Professional development being conducted at the 20 school; Input from school faculty and staff, complex 21 (5) specialists, and state office program specialists; and 22 2011-2275 SB1485 CD1 SMA.doc

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1	(6) Input from the school community council;	
2	provided further that the superintendent has made a	
3	recommendation to the board to reconstitute the school, taking	
4	into consideration the recommendation of the complex area	
5	superintendent, if any.	
6	(b) In reconstituting a public school, the superintendent	-
7	may take actions that include:	
8	(1) Replacing all or most of the staff, including	
9	teachers, principals, and other support staff;	
10	(2) Entering into a contract with a private entity to	
11	manage the school; and	
12	(3) Changing the membership of the school community	
13	council.	
14	(c) The department shall negotiate with the respective	
15	unions the process of reassigning employees of the school to be	<u>!</u>
16	reconstituted to other positions within the department for whic	h
17	che employees are qualified.	
18	(d) The department shall follow the current hiring and	
19	recruiting procedures for all employees to be employed at the	
20	reconstituted school.	
21	(e) The board shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 as	
22	may be necessary to implement this section."

1	SECTION 3. Chapter 302B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§302B-</u> Reconstituting public charter schools. (a) The
5	superintendent may recommend actions to the charter school
6	review panel that should be taken to reconstitute a charter
7	school that has been in restructuring under the No Child Left
8	Behind Act of 2001, Public Law 107-110, for four or more school
9	years, and may recommend that the charter school review panel
10	revoke the charter school's charter.
11	(b) The board shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 as
12	may be necessary to implement this section."
13	SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
