RELATING TO GRAFFITI.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 708-823.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended to read as follows:

3 "[+]§708-823.6[+] Graffiti; sentencing. (1) Whenever a 4 person is sentenced under section 708-821, 708-822, 708-823, or 5 708-823.5[τ] for an offense in which the damage is caused by 6 graffiti, in addition to any penalty prescribed by those 7 sections, the person shall be required to:

8 Remove the graffiti from the damaged property within (a) thirty days of sentencing, if it has not already been 9 10 removed and where consent from the respective property owner or owners has been obtained; and 11

12 For a period of time not to exceed two years from the (b) 13 date of sentencing, along with any other person or persons who may be sentenced under this section for 14 15 the same property, perform community service removing, within fourteen days, any graffiti applied to other 16 property within [one] two hundred fifty yards of the 17 18 site of the offense for which the person was

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1	sentenced, where consent from the respective property
2	owner or owners has been obtained, even if the
3'	property was damaged by another person $[-,]$
4	provided that removal of graffiti shall not place the person or
5	others in physical danger nor inconvenience the public.
6	(2) In lieu of performing graffiti removal pursuant to
7	subsection (1), the court may require a person to perform one
8	hundred hours of community service if the government agency that
9	is responsible for supervising the graffiti removal lacks the
10	necessary resources to ensure the person's compliance with
11	subsection (1).
12	[(2)] <u>(3)</u> For purposes of this section, "graffiti" means
13	any unauthorized drawing, inscription, figure, or mark of any
14	type intentionally created by paint, ink, chalk, dye, or similar
15	substances."
16	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
17	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
18	begun before its effective date.
19	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
20	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
21	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
