## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE FIRE COUNCIL.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECI	TION 1. The legislature finds that the state fire
2	council n	eeds to employ staff to accomplish its statutory duties
3	and respo	nsibilities. The state fire council, among other
4	things:	
5	(1)	Appoints advisory committees comprised of
6		representatives from each county fire department to
7		assist in drafting the state fire code;
8	(2)	Assists in coordinating statewide training, data
9		collection, and contingency planning needs for
10		firefighters;
11	(3)	Prescribes standard procedures and forms relating to
12		inspections, investigations, and reporting of fires;
13	(4)	Approves plans for cooperation among the county fire
14		departments;
15	(5)	Advises the governor and the legislature with respect
16		to fire prevention and protection, life safety, and
17		any other functions or activities for which the

1		various county fire departments are generally	
2		responsible;	
3	(6)	Serves as a point of contact through which all	
4		applications to the federal government for federal	
5		grant assistance for fire-related projects shall be	
6		made and administers those federal grants;	
7	(7)	Coordinates statewide fire and life safety training,	
8		education, and inspection of state buildings and	
9		facilities; and	
10	(8)	Prescribes standard procedures and forms relating to	
11		inspections, investigations, and reporting of fires.	
12	Curre	ently, the state fire council has one part-time	
13	administrative assistant position, and there is no statutory		
14	provision	for the hiring of staff. More positions are needed	
15	for the state fire council to fulfill its statutory mandate and		
16	to protect the public safety.		
17	The purpose of this Act is to allow the state fire counci		
18	to employ an administrator and administrative assistant.		
19	SECTION 2. Chapter 132, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
20	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
21	and to rea	ad as follows:

1	" <u>§</u> 13	32- Administrative staffing for the state fire
2	council.	(a) The state fire council may employ on a full-time
3	basis an	administrator and administrative assistant, without
4	regard to	chapters 76 and 89. The administrator shall
5	administe	er the affairs of the state fire council at the
6	direction	of the council. The state fire council shall
7	determine	the compensation for the administrator and the
8	administr	cative assistant.
9	(b)	The administrator and administrative assistant shall
10	assist th	e state fire council in carrying out the duties of the
11	council u	inder section 132-16, including:
12	(1)	Administration of the daily operations of the state
13		<pre>fire council;</pre>
14	(2)	Administration of the adoption process of the state
15		fire code by the counties;
16	(3)	Submission of applications for and expending of
17	•	federal grants and assistance for fire-related
18		projects;
19	(4)	Administration of the reduced ignition propensity
20	·	cigarette program;
21	(5)	Coordination of the statewide fire and life safety
22		training, education, and data collection programs; and

1	(6) Implementation of other related duties as directed by
2	the state fire council.
3	(c) The budgetary requirements for conducting meetings and
4	other related functions of the state fire council, including the
5	salaries of the administrator and administrative assistant,
6	shall be included in the budget of the department of labor and
7	industrial relations."
8	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
