A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VOG.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) There shall be established within the 2 civil defense agency of a county with an active volcano from 3 which vog emanates, the interagency task force on vog. The task 4 force shall review the effects and impact of vog on human health, school children, agriculture, farm and ranch animals, 5 6 public infrastructure, the visitor industry, and any other issue the task force deems necessary. The task force shall make 7 recommendations to the legislature on addressing any issue the 8 9 task force determines is feasible to address pursuant to this 10 Act. The task force may adopt resolutions encompassing any issue being reviewed by the task force and may forward these 11 12 resolutions to any federal, state, or county agency for 13 appropriate action.

14 (b) The interagency task force on vog shall meet quarterly
15 at a place and time to be determined by the chair of the task
16 force. Meeting notices shall be posted by the task force as
17 required under chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and public

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1 testimony at meetings shall be accepted by the task force. The task force shall be dissolved on June 30, 2013. (C) The civil defense agency of the county with an active volcano from which vog emanates shall provide administrative support, including the recording of minutes, to the interagency task force on vog. (d) The administrator of the civil defense agency of the county with an active volcano from which voq emanates shall be the chair of the interagency task force on vog. The task force shall include the following members or their designees: The director of health, or the director's designee; (1)(2)The vice director of civil defense, department of defense; (3) The representative of the fourth representative district; The representative of the fifth representative (4) district; The senator of the second senatorial district; (5)(6) Hawaii county council members representing lower Puna and Kau; The fire chief of the Hawaii county fire department; (7)
