## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 6 SECTION 4. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as
- 7 interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest
- 8 shall be limited to the period from the date of judgment, if
- 9 applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this Act,
- 10 as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for those
- 11 cases to which the statute applies.
- 12 SECTION 5. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
- 13 appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
- 14 June 30, 2012, shall lapse.
- 15 SECTION 6. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 16 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 17 invalid, the invalidity does not effect other provisions or
- 18 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 19 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 20 of this Act are severable.
- 21 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
