5	(1)	A vehicle [propelled solely by human power] upon which
6		any person may ride, having two tandem wheels, and
7		including any vehicle generally recognized as a
8		bicycle though equipped with two front or two rear
9		wheels except a toy bicycle[+]; or
10	(2)	A vehicle upon which any person may ride that has two
11		tandem wheels, including any vehicle generally
12		recognized as a bicycle even if equipped with two
13		front or two rear wheels and an electric motor that
14		produces less than one and one-half gross brake
15		horsepower and is capable of propelling the vehicle at
16		a maximum speed of not more than twenty-five miles per
17		hour on level around;

2	specifications shall be allowed to be transported on buses used		
3	in public transportation systems: wheel bases not longer than		
4	forty-four inches; tires that are not more than 2.3 inches wide;

6	of not more than fifty-five pounds."		
7	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
8	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
9	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
