A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ALOHA TOWER DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 206J-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "§206J-3 Aloha Tower complex; designated boundaries. The 4 Aloha Tower complex is established.
