## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ALOHA TOWER DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 206J-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§206J-3 Aloha Tower complex; designated boundaries. 4 Aloha Tower complex is established. The complex shall include 5 the area bounded by Nimitz Highway beginning at its intersection 6 with the Diamond Head boundary of tax map key 2-1-13:7 north 7 along Nimitz Highway to its intersection [with the makai 8 boundary of tax map key 1 7 1:6; northeast along River Street to 9 its intersection with King Street; north along King Street to 10 its intersection with Iwilei Road west along Iwilei Road to its 11 intersection with Nimitz Highway at the Ewa makai corner of tax 12 map key 1 5 08:1; south along Nimitz Highway to its intersection 13 with the boundary between tax map key 1-5-8:1 and tax map key 1-14 5 8:9; west along a line to the Diamond Head mauka corner of tax 15 map key 1 5 40:4; west along Nimitz Highway to its intersection 16 with the Ewa boundary of tax map key 1 5 38:4; south along the 17 Ewa boundaries of tax map key 1-5-38:4 and 1-5-38:5 to Honolulu 18 Harbor; east along the waterfront boundary of tax map key 1-5-

1 There is established the Aloha Tower development "(a) 2 corporation, which shall be a public body corporate and politic, 3 a public instrumentality, and an agency of the State. 4 development corporation shall be placed within the department of 5 [business, economic development, and tourism] transportation for 6 administrative purposes, pursuant to section 26-35. 7 (b) [Except as provided in section 206J-5.5, the] The 8 development corporation shall consist of a board of directors 9 having [seven] three voting members [-]: The director of 10 business, economic development, and tourism, the director of 11 transportation, [the chairperson of the board of land and 12 natural resources, and the mayor of the city and county of 13 Honolulu, or their respective designated representatives, shall 14 serve as ex officio voting members.] and the deputy director of 15 transportation, harbors division. These members shall serve without compensation, but each member 4 shall be reimbursed for expenses, including travel expenses, 5 6 incurred in the performance of their duties. 7 (q) Subject to existing contractual and statutory commitments to the department of transportation for any losses 8 9 in revenue under this chapter, the development corporation may 10 apply any revenues derived from commercial development projects 11 in the Aloha Tower project area to defray the cost of harbor infrastructure improvements incurred within the State."] 12 13 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the Aloha Tower 14 fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 for operating expenses for 15 the Aloha Tower development corporation. 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 17 18 transportation for the purposes of this Act. SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 20

SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
