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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a shortage of school
2	supplies for the classroom and funds to purchase those supplies
3	has been an ongoing problem for many years. The legislature
4	believes that to properly address this problem, a school's
5	purchasing power should be concentrated at the classroom level
6	through the use of debit cards. Debit cards would allow
7	teachers to make specific purchases within a set dollar limit.
8	The benefits of a debit card system include:
9	(1) Streamlining the reimbursement process for teachers
10	who purchase necessary school supplies and other
11	related curriculum support supplies; and
12	(2) Providing teachers with purchasing flexibility to take
13	advantage of school discounts and sales in the
14	community.
15	The legislature further finds that there are banks that can
16	assist with the establishment of debit card system accounts at

17 little or no cost that provide up-to-date spending information.



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1	The purpose of this Act is to allow the principal of each
2	public school to establish and use a debit card system based at
3	the individual school level to purchase school supplies and
4	other related curriculum support supplies.
5	SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
7	and to read as follows:
8	"§302A- Purchases of supplies; debit card system. The
9	principal of each public school may establish and use a debit
10	card system, based at the individual school level to enable
11	teachers at that school to purchase school supplies and other
12	related curriculum support supplies; provided that the system is
13	consistent with the school's academic and financial plans."
14	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
15	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
16	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year $2011-2012$ and
17	the same sum or so much as may be necessary for fiscal year
18	2012-2013, to implement a debit card system based at the
19	individual school level to purchase school supplies and other
20	related curriculum support supplies pursuant to section
21	302A- , Hawaii Revised Statutes.



The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
education for the purposes of this Act.
SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
