A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act 2 of 2010 provides for the establishment by 2014 of health insurance exchanges which will facilitate the purchase and sale 3 4 of federally qualified health insurance plans and provide a connection between buyers and sellers of those plans. 5 The intent 6 of the health insurance exchange is to reduce the number of uninsured, to provide a transparent marketplace and consumer 7 education, and to assist individuals with access to programs, 8 premium assistance, tax credits, and cost-sharing reductions. 9 10 The legislature finds that the people of Hawaii will be best 11 served by a health insurance exchange that is operated in Hawaii.

Because a federal grant to support the operations of a health insurance exchange will become available and the Secretary of the United States Department of Health and Human Services will determine whether Hawaii can implement a health insurance exchange, the legislature finds that moving forward in the 2011 legislative session with an enabling statute is prudent.

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE

PURPOSE: To provide for the establishment of a health insurance exchange authority required by the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010 to facilitate the purchase and sale of and provide a connection between buyers and sellers of federally qualified health insurance plans.

MEANS: Amend the Hawaii Revised Statutes by adding a new chapter enabling a health insurance exchange authority.

JUSTIFICATION: If the Legislature determines that the people of Hawaii would best be served by a health insurance exchange operated in Hawaii, legislation enabling a health insurance exchange authority to implement the federal requirements is necessary.

> <u>Impact on the public:</u> The intent of this bill is to reduce the number of uninsured, provide consumer education and a more transparent marketplace, and assist individuals with access to programs, premium assistance tax credits and cost-sharing reductions.

> Impact on the department and other agencies: The department has created a Task Force to address issues regarding the implementation of a health insurance exchange in Hawaii. The health insurance exchange authority will be placed within the department for administrative purposes and shall be a public body and a body corporate and politic.
