A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CERTIFICATION OF PRINCIPALS AND VICE-PRINCIPALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of
education currently has requirements for the certification of
its principals and vice-principals. The legislature also finds
that the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009
provides educational funds for states that pursue educational
reform and additional funds for those states that qualify for
Race to the Top funds by advancing educational reform.

One of the selection criteria for the Race to the Top funds 8 is providing alternative routes to certification for teachers 9 and principals. Although the legislature previously amended 10 section 302A-605, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to establish 11 alternative routes to certification, the current requirement 12 that a principal candidate possess not less than five years of 13 appropriate school-level experience, of which at least three 14 years shall have been as a teacher, is too restrictive and 15 conflicts with the Race to the Top grant requirements. 16

1 The purpose of this Act is to provide principal and vice-2 principal candidates alternate routes of certification that meet the federal Race to the Top requirements. 3 4 SECTION 2. Section 302A-605, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows: 5 6 "(a) Principals shall meet the department's certification 7 requirements and shall have at least five years of appropriate 8 school-level experience, including at least three years as a 9 teacher [-], or equivalent experience, as determined by the 10 department. 11 (b) Vice-principals shall meet the department's certification requirements and shall have appropriate school-12 level or equivalent experience, as determined by the 13 14 department." SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 15 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 17
