A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CONSERVATION AND RESOURCES ENFORCEMENT SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 199, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 Conservation and resources enforcement special "§199-5 fund; established. (a) There is hereby established in the 6 treasury of the State a special fund known as the conservation 7 and resources enforcement special fund, which shall be 8 administered by the department of land and natural resources. 9 (b) -The following shall be deposited into the conservation 10 and resources enforcement special fund: 11 Grants, awards, donations, gifts, transfers, or moneys (1) derived from public or private sources for the 12 13 purposes of enforcing the provisions of title 12, 14 chapters 6D, 6E, and 6K, or any rule adopted 15 thereunder; 16 (2) Fees, reimbursements, administrative charges, and 17 penalties collected for activities related to the

There is appropriated out of the conservation 5 and resources enforcement special fund the sum of \$ or 6 so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 7 for the purposes of covering expenses related to enforcing 8 natural, cultural, and historic resources protection laws and 9 rules.

10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
11 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
12 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
13 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
